

1. The map shows the managed aquifer recharge (MAR) sites in the states of Australia.




3. The world map shows tracks of hurricanes, tropical cyclones, and typhoons.

5. The photograph shows a glaciated landscape and a footbridge in New Zealand.
















### Option G — Urban environments
